Road & Bridge Maintenance Policy-2010:

OBJECTIVE:

- Safe access for road users.
- Efficient allocation of available funds and resources for the maintenance and repair of roads.
- Programming of repair work in consonance with the reconstruction / rehabilitation / improvement programme.
- Development of a system for recording and reporting on the condition of roads and bridges.
- Creation of a funding mechanism to finance maintenance of road assets on a permanent and sustainable basis.
- Participation of various stakeholders in maintaining existing roads.

Approach & Implementation:

- Establishment of a Road and Bridge Management System which shall include a data collection system, database and an automated analytical process for planning and programming of road works.
- Data for the Road database shall be collected at the Division level and the same shall be compiled at the Head Quarter level by Road & Bridge Maintenance (RMS) unit for the all State Highways and MDRs.
- Updating shall be done on yearly basis.

Development of Different Module for the Maintenance system.

Construction contract along with maintenance

- Approval of Annual Maintenance Programme in the beginning of the Financial year for Routine Maintenance / PR works and execution of works accordingly. The PR cycle shall be as per IRC norms.
- Urgent works of original nature shall be approved and executed under SR.
- Repair of roads damaged by heavy rains/flood, water logging etc. shall be approved and executed under FDR/Emergent repair

Output performance based contract

- Service level defined on the basis of roughness and IRC norms
- Provision for improving the road condition in first year of contract as per defined performance level
- Monitoring during contract period, 3rd party evaluation, penalty/ prize for due diligence of the contract

- A regulatory framework is under decision for O&M Program at State level.
- OMT documents issued by Planning Commission is to be adopted.
- Adaptation of modified EPC contract (construction plus maintenance) as per Planning commission
- Leveraged Annuity Fund through financial intermediation loan from ADB


